POSTER AND ESSAY CONTEST RULES

This contest is sponsored by Texas Water Utilities Association to introduce students to the water environment and processes involved in supplying a modern community with safe water and wastewater treatment.

CONTEST AWARDS:

First Place: \$200.00 (Check)
Second Place \$100.00 (Check)
Third Place \$50.00 (Check)

All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place poster/essay winners will be displayed at the Texas Water Utilities Association "Annual School" March 1st – 4th, 2020 at the American Bank Convention Center, in Corpus Christi, Texas. All selected winners will be included in the May issue of the TWUA Journal as well.

POSTER/ESSAY CONTEST RULES:

- 1. To enter, students shall be in grades 4, 5, or 6 at the time of the contest, and must submit a poster, an essay, or both.
- 2. Poster entries must be in <u>PORTRAIT</u> format (11" wide X 17" high) and suitable for matting. NO OTHER SIZE WILL BE PERMITTED AND WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. Do not use copyrighted characters as these cannot be reproduced. Paints, charcoal drawings, pen and ink, crayon or pastel sketches made from original work may be used for your poster.





- 3. Essay entries should be at least 150 words, but not more than 400 words in length.
- 4. Each entry (poster or essay) must have an official entry form attached. Forms may be reproduced as necessary. The questions on the entry form must be answered in the space provided and each form must have the signature of the teacher who will be submitting the entries.
- 5. Only full-time students in the State of Texas are eligible and they must be enrolled in grades 4, 5, or 6 on the entry date. Teachers may submit ONLY the TOP THREE POSTER entries and the TOP THREE ESSAY entries from each class. SUBMITTING MORE THAN THIS NUMBER OF ENTRIES WILL DISQUALIFY EVERYONE.
- **6.** Entries are to be mailed or delivered to:

- 7. All entries must be postmarked no later than January 25, 2020.
- 8. Decisions of the judges are final. Winners will be announced February 21, 2020. Winner's information can be obtained on TWUA website at http://www.twua.org click on the (About Tab) following announcements.
- 9. Entries become the property of the Texas Water Utilities Association and cannot be returned or acknowledged.
